



Comfort Throw

Pattern by Anne Woodall for Knit Traders

Size: Approx. 40" x 52"

Yarn:

Cascade Yarns, El Cielo (89% superfine alpaca/11% nylon; 579.6 yds/100gm skein): Color 07, 1 skein

Patons, Shetland Chunky (75% acrylic/25% wool; 148 yds/100gm): charcoal, 4 skeins

Hayfield, Chunky Tweed with Wool (74% acrylic/20% wool/6% viscose; 158 yds/100gm): shade 0183, 4 skeins

Needles:

15mm/ US 19, 32" circular

Gauge: not essential for this project but approx. 6sts to 4"

Directions:

Holding 1 strand of each of the three colours together, loosely cast on 78 sts

Work 4 rows in garter stitch (knit every row)

1st pattern row: (wrong side) K3, purl to last 3 stitches. K3

2nd pattern row: knit

Repeat these two rows until piece measures approx. 38" from the cast on edge.

Work 4 rows in garter stitch.

Bind off loosely and weave in ends
