



# Ridged Baktus Scarf

## A Knit Traders Pattern

### Yarn:

Knit Traders Ridged Baktus Scarf Kit

### OR

2 - 50g balls of DK weight yarn (Note: if you want to use one 100g skien, simply divide it into 2 balls as precisely as possible.

### Needles:

4mm/US 6, 32"

### Abbreviations:

K1tbl: knit stitch through the back loop

SL1: slip 1 stitch

PSSO: pass slipped stitch over last knit stitch

## Directions:

Cast on 4 stitches.

Rows 1 & 2: with 1st ball of yarn, knit to the last stitch, K1tbl

Row 3: with 2nd ball of yarn, knit to the last stitch and increase by knitting through the front and back of this stitch.

Row 4: with 2nd ball of yarn, knit to the last stitch, K1tbl

Repeat these 4 rows until approximately 1/2 of each ball has been used or until at least inches from cast on edge. (Store sample was increased to 60 sts)

### Decreases:

Rows 1 & 2: with 1st ball of yarn, knit to the last stitch, K1tbl

Row 3: with 2nd ball of yarn, knit to last 2 stitches, SL1 purlwise, K1tbl, pssso

Row 4: with 2nd ball of yarn, knit to the last stitch, Krtbl

Repeat these 4 rows until only 4 stitches remain. Cast off knitwise and sew in all ends. Block gently if required.
